Fast Facts

- Table Wine (mostly just in Italy)
- IGT - typical grapes & regional wine style
- DOC - Tight regulations, high quality, consistent product
- DOCG - Strict regulations, highest quality wines in a region
-
- Classico - from a smaller, original vineyard area
- Superiore - made to a higher standard than required
- Reserva - aged longer, typically 1 year longer than required
